

BSHC Website report to the BSHC 30th Conference

SMA as manager of the BSHC Website hereby report the following.

1. Status of the website

Since the last conference the BSHC website has been up and running without any known interruptions.

Alarms is in place to identify malfunctions in the Domain Name Server where we still use the Amazon S53 for management. Very few short-lived alerts regarding DNS accessibility have been received, but required no actions.

The CDWCWG page is still the most frequently updated and visited, followed by the NSHC TWG page that also resides in the BSHC system (accessed only by direct link) and the BSCD2000 information page.

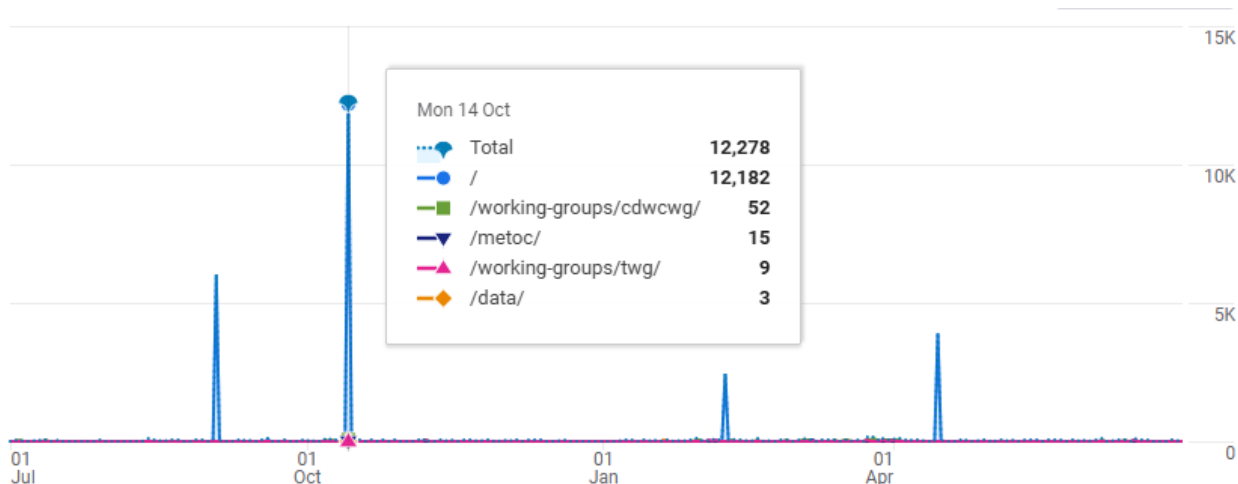
2. The use of the BSHC website

SMA is coordinating the site and will continue to publish information sent to sma@sjofartsverket.se for inclusion on the site. For the best result, please be clear when sending documents on where and how they should be published and also make sure all information is updated and relevant.

WG chairs can be granted a login with permission to update their subpages if preferred. (This might require translation of the present “manual” for editing of the site).

For this report we have used the new Google statistics scheme for the last year.



The statistics, for the period 1 July 2024 to 30 June 2025, indicates that there seems to have been some attempts of attacks 4 times during the period. The attacks seems to be from all around the globe with USA, India, Japan, Brazil and China as main originator of the traffic. This makes the statistics rather problematic to show as a true graph. All those calls have been made directly to the www.bshc.pro page, hence we have removed all those calls during these days from the statistics below.

During the period 1 July 2024 to 30 June 2025, we have had 10.7k visits by 3.8k separate users. These numbers above include also the NSHC-TWG page that had 1k visits.

The number/list of registered active links to the website cannot be found in the new analytics tool. However, 2.3k of the visitors has arrived to our website by the use of search engines and 1.2k via links in documents or webpages.
