# Actions from last meeting

- Chair – Bring issue of sub-area border to WWNWS and report back.
- Chair – Reply to formal question from HSSC chair and BSHC that BSMSIWG should not coordinate implementation of S-4XX in the Baltic Sea, but to coordinate with WMO.
- METAREA I – Report to BSMSIWG meetings about the potential MET sub-area in the Baltic.
- All – Provide shape files with closed polygons with each nations waters to NAVAREA I.
- NAVAREA I – Combine the provided polygons into one file and report back.
- Sweden Traffic – Education of operators on correct procedures regarding priority classes, in particular regarding Vital warnings.
- All – Make sure that National coordinators and MSI providers understand implications and instructions regarding priority classes.
- All – Check if MS has a production code for S-124. If not, consider applying for a production code.
- All – Consider way forward for S-124 implementation.
