At the last Chart Datum, Water level and Currents Working Group (<u>CDWCWG</u>) meeting in Tallinn 25-26 March 2025, we decided to organize a **S-104/S-111 Harmonisation subgroup** [<u>Minutes</u>, <u>List of Actions</u>].

## CDWCWG2 Action #14:

Organize a S-104 and S-111 harmonisation subgroup and invite members to the group

You have all been identified as valuable members of this group and are hereby invited to our first meeting. Please let me know if you think somebody else will join the group as well. The action is done in cooperation with the <u>Baltic Sea e-Nav project</u>, where Traficom (Marisofia Nurmi) coordinates the harmonisation for all S-100 standards. FMI (Anni Jokiniemi) coordinates and collaborates with SMHI (Patrik) on the S-104/S-111 implementation.

A first version of a <u>Regional product harmonisation document for S-104 and S-111</u> has been drafted. Please read it and provide your comments and feedback at the meeting or by 19<sup>th</sup> June 2025.

Our ambition and the first goal of the group is to have a first version of the document, to be presented and acknowledged at the BSHC30 Conference, 22-24 September 2025 in Riga. Last due date for the report and submissions to the Conference is six weeks prior to the meeting, i.e. 2025-08-15.

We will also try to coordinate as much as possible with the other standards, such as S-102. Please find attached the first version of the **Regional product harmonisation guidelines for S-102,** produced in cooperation between the <u>Baltic Sea e-Nav project</u> and <u>BSICCWG</u>. A new version will be available this summer.

You are very welcome to give input and feedback about our way forward.
