Dear BSHC and Re-Survey Monitoring Working Group Colleagues,

This letter contains information based on the decisions of the BSHC 21st Conference on 25-27 Sept 2016, Klaipeda, Lithuania. Also it contains information of the forthcoming MWG14 meeting on 11 Dec 2016 at German Hhydrographic Office (Bundesamt für Seeshifffahrt und Hydrographie), Rostock, Germany.

1. BSHC21 decisions concerning BSHC Re-Survey Monitoring Working Group (MWG)

The MWG report was presented by MWG chair Mr. Seppo Mäkinen The Conference took note the MWG report and:

- encouraged member states to study and define Cat I & II areas in their waters based on the existing AIS-information on commercial shipping
- · encouraged member states to perform re-surveys in areas of commercial shipping
- encouraged member states to participate MWG work
- The BSHC21 did not append the MWG work program for 2014-2016 and did not give further guidance, so we continue as planned;
- 2. Re-Survey DataBase interface is now updated for testing

Swedish Maritime Administration personnel at BSHC21 reported the BSHC Re-Survey DataBase interface opened for testing. Updates of national records have to wait for some weeks, until the data editing and updating is available. We will be informed from our Swedish colleagues later, when editing is available.

- to draft work program for 2017-2020[chair];
- to plan for a MWG15 meeting (time and proposals for venue are welcomed) [chair];

MWG14 will have combined meeting session together with NSHC MWG after lunch, until about 13:30, when participants need to depart for travel (Railway station). During this session it is feasible to go through and discuss Baltic Sea Bathymetric DB and Re-Survey BD issues and experiences;
